Dear Mr Applebaum,


I wonder if you can help me over what has become a delicate matter. As you know, the family of the late Leslie Slot gave a handsome donation to the KKL for a playground project on Har Halutz. I had assumed that all was going well but was recently told that the project for the playground will not proceed and the family are asked to agree to divert this donation for another and certainly worthy project in an Arab village in the Galil.

It is entirely possible that this will happen regardless of what I may say, but I would very much like to know if this matter has been discussed with you and your settlers in any way, and your reaction to the proposal. I am told by a KKL official in Israel that as and when Har Halutz is ready for such a project they will find the necessary funds though my confidence in such promises is not as strong as having had the actual gift!

I am sharing a copy of this with Dick Hirsch as well, so that he is aware of this development, and if you can drop me a line as soon as convenient, I will be grateful to you.
