Affiliated with the movement for progressive Judaism, Har Halutz was established on 12 Tishrei, 5746 (September 27, 1985) when the first nine families moved into their temporary homes at the site.

As of November 1986 Har Halutz community numbers fourteen families and the projection is to reach thirty families by the end of 1987. The building of the permanent housing will start next year.

Planned for 180 families, the settlement is comprised of immigrants from all over the world, as well as Israelis, who share the ideals of religious pluralism, friendly interaction with all our neighboring communities and the strengthening the links between the diaspora and the state of Israel.
